Senator for Urban Development and Environment of the Free and Hanseatic City of Hamburg from 2008 to 2010; member of the Hamburg Parliament, deputy chairwoman of the Alliance 90/The Greens parliamentary group on the Hamburg Parliament and spokeswoman on budgetary policy for the parliamentary group from 2011 to 2013.

Member of the German Bundestag again since 2013.
